# **Grover Cleveland Golf Course Updates**

Aeration of the greens is scheduled for September 16 and 17. At this point the plan is to have 9 holes available for play each day. Any holes that have temporary greens in effect are not eligible for the hole-in-one payout. Also, USGA rules do not allow relief from aeration holes on greens. Play them as best you can! The BGC weekly tournaments are completed, so it won't affect tournament play, but remember the USGA rules if you're playing a Sweeps round!
